## Season

S - Spring, summer, and fall (migration and summer)

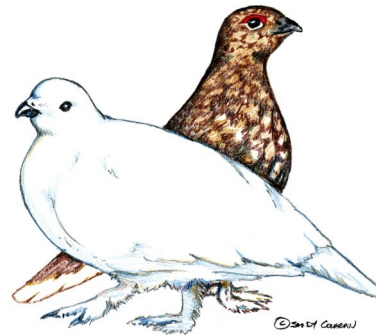
